CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If In Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is extremely toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either a soft cloth or fine mist spray.

TO WIPE ON: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulder, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies are most often seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin. After application brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat. Repeat daily or as required.

USE AS A SPRAY: This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area over and around stable horses for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with this product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent onto shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: call a local solid waste facility or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down in any indoor or outdoor drain.
